What Is A Hero?

- 1. A person distinguished for valor, fortitude, or bold enterprise; anyone regarded as having displayed great courage or exceptionally noble qualities, or who has done a deed or deeds showing him/her to possess such qualities.
- 2. In classical mythology, the son or daughter of a god or goddess and a mortal; the eponymous founder of a city or family, as Cadmus, was sometimes locally worshipped as a hero/heroine.
- 3. The central figure of a poem, play, romance, or the like; in modern fiction, the character in whom the principal interest centers.
